Messaggio del Presidente - George Golfieri

Cari Amici,

I would like to begin my message by recognizing the *Mangiamo committee*, Susan Cole (Chair), Christl Unglaub, Virginia Smith, Virginia Wilburn, and Les Villanyi. These members go above and beyond in their support for the Foundation. There is a lot of planning and hard work that goes on behind the scenes to plan the NBICF dinners. Here is an update on repairs to the Italian Cultural Center's roof and ceiling. The roof, ceiling, and A/C have been repaired, but at a substantial financial cost to the Foundation. The Foundation's available net cash reserves were reduced by \$9,238 or 21%. The Board of Directors works tirelessly to accomplish our mission of serving our cultural community, and the Foundation needs your support to continue our good work of providing a much-needed sense of community. Thirty-one years after the ratification of the Declaration of Independence, Giuseppe Garibaldi was born on July 4, 1807 in Nice. Garibaldi was an Italian general, patriot, revolutionary, and republican. He contributed to the Italian unification and the creation of the Kingdom of Italy in 1860. The Kingdom of Italy claimed all of the territory which is modernday Italy. Garibaldi is considered one of the greatest generals of modern times and one of Italy's "fathers of the fatherland." He died in 1882 in Caprera, Kingdom of Italy.

A side note on Nice: at that time, Nice was part of the House of Savoy which became the kingdom of Piedmont-Sardinia. Nice did not become a part of France until 1860 when it was handed over as part of the treaty of Turin.

How many members recall watching cartoons on Saturday mornings on TV?

Do you remember one of the most famous cartoon characters "**Woody Woodpecker**"? Woody Woodpecker and his trade mark laugh were created by Walter Lantz.

Walter Lantz was born on April 27, 1899 to immigrant parents from Castiglione, Cosentino, Italy. Their Italian surname was Lanza, but was anglicized by immigration officials at Ellis Island to Lantz. Lantz went on to create many other cartoon characters and made more than 800 short films, about 200 of them featuring the redheaded Woody Woodpecker with his trade mark laugh **"ha-ha-HA-ha.** Lantz died in 1994.
